



Field Day 2004

Dave Martin, WA6TYJ, reported (in a memo because he was at a MARS training) that Field Day 2004 was both fun and successful. He thanked the many members that contributed time, equipment and labor to the event. The club added one new member, Seiji Kawano, and the VE session resulted in a New Technician licensee. Tom Schiller reported that the GOTA station made 161 contacts and other contacts totaled 1, 537 totaling 1,698. This did not include the bonus points. **Special credit goes to Rob Thorsen who made an ISS contact, one of only 60 made during Field Day.**

Club Trailer

There was discussion about getting the license up to date on the trailer. Fees would be \$120 without the late fees and \$235 with the late fees. Mike AE6FL will investigate what our options are and if fees can be reduced or waived. Also, we will see if it is possible to get an emergency plate of some sort.

Program

John and Jane Thornton gave a power point presentation about their visit to the KPH Commercial Wireless Station at Bolinas, California. The station provided radio traffic between ships at sea and land based points. Much of the operation was CW and later radioteletype. It was five years ago that the last commercial traffic was carried using morse code and we were able to listen to the commemorative broadcast today during the meeting.
